"GREAT SUCCESS FOR THE MULTIPLIER EVENTS OF THE GREEN FUTURE PROJECT"

The Green Future project produced four main results to foster sustainable business incubation for people at risk of exclusion in rural areas.

in the last stage of the project, the partners are working on developing a sustainability strategy to ensure that these results will remain available and will be used by more and more people after the project end.

One of the key sustainability and exploitation action is the organization of the multiplier events, to foster the participation of stakeholders and rural communities in a process of exchange of experience and co-creation of follow up actions. Seven Multiplier events will maximise Green Future impact and outreach at a global scale.



MULTIPLIER EVENTS OVERVIEW





IRLAND- Meath Community Rural and Social Development Partnership On the 11th of June, Meath Partnership held a very successful Entrepreneurship Day, where we launched the Green Future platform. Our guest speakers were inspirational entrepreneurs from Reuzi and Awesome Creations, who were warmly welcomed by all in attendance. Information sessions on funding supports were given by Meath Partnership LEADER programme and the Local Enterprise Office, along with a workshop on using social media for business. . FRANCE- Les 7 Vents Two events took place in France: on the 28th of November 2023, Les 7 Vents held MEETINGS ON THE CREATION OF ACTIVITIES AND ENTERPRISES IN COUTANCES: Entrepreneurship, why? how? with whom? as part of Social and Solidarity Economy month, to provide an opportunity for exchanges between the various players, support and funding structures, social workers and project leaders. On the 18th of June 2024, at Biopousses farm - an agricultural test area, on the occasion of the European partners' visit to Coutances, Les 7 Vents held a meeting day with local structures linked to business creation and integration, to present the various projects underway in La Manche and other EU regions, and to share best practice.



SPAIN- Empresas Con Valores

On the 14th of May 2024, ACV hosted the multiplier event at Hoku Space (Valencia, Spain), which was attended by 37 people. During the event, we presented the impact of the Green Future project and all the results of the initiative, sharing all our green business ideas and inviting everyone to join the project's platform.



ITALY- <u>Consorzio Social Lab Società Cooperativa Socia</u>le On the 16th of July 2024, Consorzio Social Lab hosted the multiplier event in "La Cittadella del bambino" in Bitonto: the 30 participants had the opportunity to know the project, its aims, the achieved results and the available resources, and the results of the loal piloting. They also had the chance to test the incubation platform available for starting entrepreneurs in rural areas.



POLAND- <u>Stowarzyszenie ARID</u> On the 20th of July 2024, ARID organized the multiplier event at the University Przyrodniczy in Wrocław, which was attended by 20 people. The participants had the opportunity to learn about the project, its outcomes, and the available resources. They also had the chance to try out the incubation platform designed for new entrepreneurs in rural areas.



CYPRUS- <u>HEARTHANDS SOLUTIONS</u> The last multiplier event will take place on July 26th in Cyprus: participants will be informed about the results of the Green Future project, including best practices, a business idea bank, and an online tool that guides users in developing a business. There will be also a workshop on entrepreneurship
